NV_Drusian, Spumante Extra-Dry Prosecco di Valdobbiadene, Veneto, Italy

This Extra Dry Prosecco opens with frothy cream and floral tones of jasmine and honeysuckle. It tastes lively and fresh in the mouth, thanks to its well-integrated acidity and its piquant effervescence.

NV Louis Roederer Brut, Reims, Champagne, France 90 points **Wine Spectator**

Lovely aromas and flavors of hazelnut, honey and citrus mingle with a firm yet rich structure in this elegant, well-toned Champagne.

A subtle version, with a smoky undertow and hints of white cherry, pomegranate, toasted almond and ground spice, structured by firm acidity and a moderate bead.

Very fresh, with good cut to the bitter almond, mineral, melon rind, followed by a lingering finish.

Quinta de la Rosa 10 Year Old Tawny Port, Douro, Portugal **92 points**

Aromas of crushed berries and orange peel, with a hint of fresh herbs. Full-bodied, slightly sweet, with plenty of ripe fruit and firm tannins.

2000 Fonseca Vintage Port, Portugal **94 points** **Wine Spectator**

Medium-bodied, with a fresh allure to the flavors of baked apricot, dried mango and cherry tart. This is long and delicate on the spice-filled finish.

Dessert Wines

NV Torres, Moscatel Oro, DO Catalunya, Medalla de Oro Muscat du Monde 2006

Of a fine amber color, with dark topaz tints, it exhibits in all their splendor the *fruity* (orange blossom honey, candied orange, lemon peel, raisins), *floral* (rose, geranium, lily) and *spiced* (tobacco leaf, rosewood, clove) aromas of the Moscatel variety. On the palate, it is a marvel of balance: its honeyed, perfumed sugars

are set off by a fine fruity acidity,

2019 Delas Freres Muscat de Beaumes-de-Venise La Pastourelle, Rhone, France

Shows spice and nectarine hints up front, then turns racy and minerally, with persimmon and orange blossom notes and a pretty, lingering finish.

2019 Chateau Simon Barsac-Sauternes France

With a brilliant yellow color, its nose is intense with exotic and citrus fruit notes. The attack is round and fruity, rich and fresh. After aeration, this wine develops spicy (cinnamon, vanilla) and fresh (menthol) notes associated with exotic and dry fruit notes; the final is pleasantly woody.

2001 Trimbach Gewurztraminer Selection de Grains Nobles, Alsace, France **93 points** **Wine Spectator**

Spice and hard candy notes are the main themes, with ginger, cardamom and citrus flavors.

It's elegant for Gewürztraminer, with a pungent spicy aftertaste.

2008 Chateau Dereszla, Tokaji Aszú 6 Puttonyos, Hungary **96 points** **Wine Spectator**

This rich sweetie delivers dark undertones of coffee, spice and tobacco to the syrupy dried apricot puree, dried mango and light date notes. Powerful, featuring a detailed, spicy finish
